

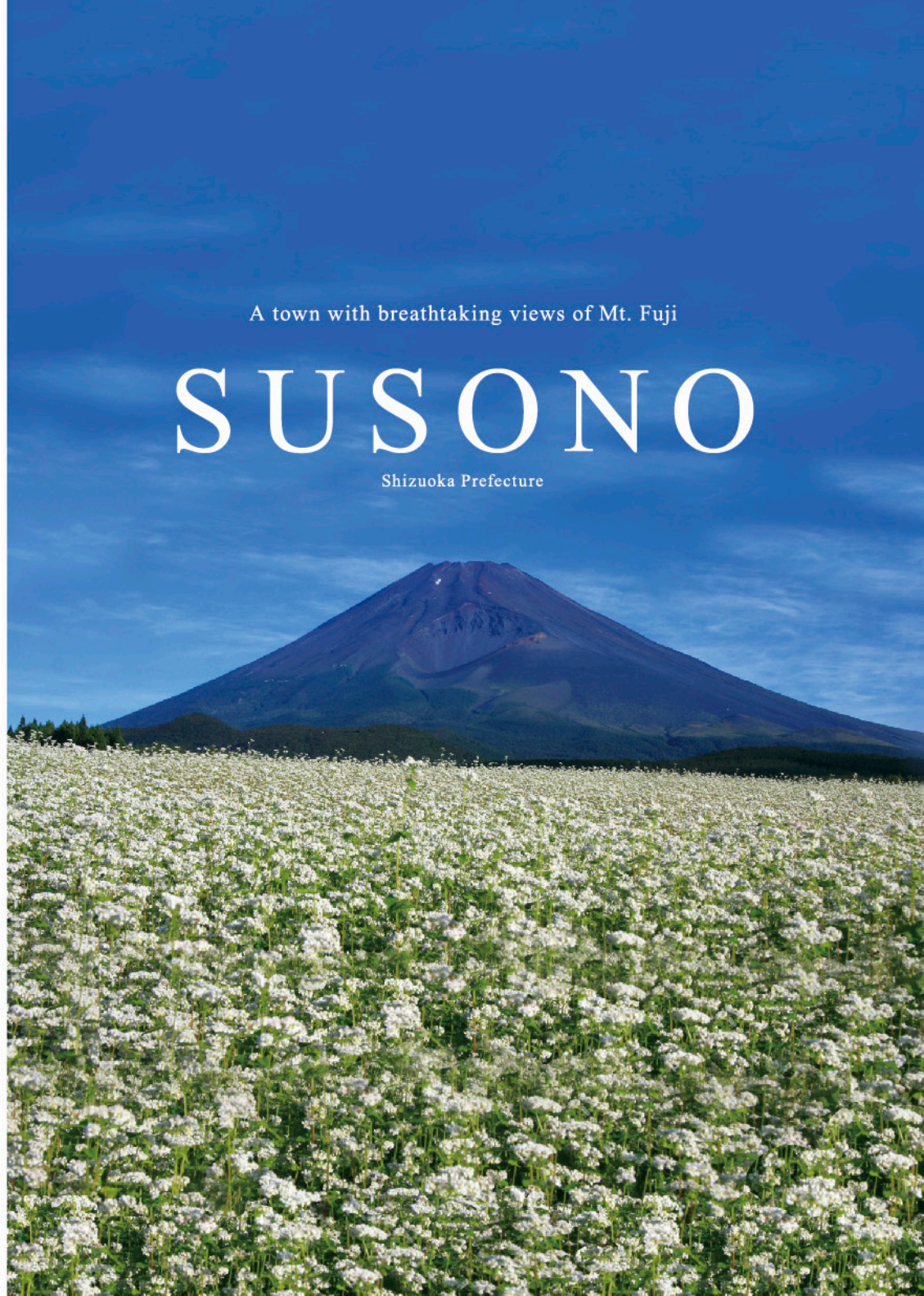

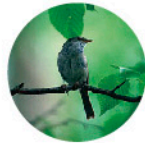

Heritage Components of the Mt. Fuji World Heritage Site

Suyama Sengen Shrine Located approximately 10 minutes by car from the Susono I.C.

<Nationally Designated Historical Site>

Suyama Sengen is a shrine that has become the starting point of the Suyama mountain climbing trail. It is believed to have been founded by Yamato Takeru no Mikoto, and its presence was reaffirmed in the year 1524 by Torii. The mountain trails and the shrine suffered severe damage in the Hiei eruption of 1707, but it was rebuilt in 1823 as it remains today. The shrine's precincts are shaded by giant Japanese cedars, including a sacred tree, and the area is enveloped in a sacred atmosphere.

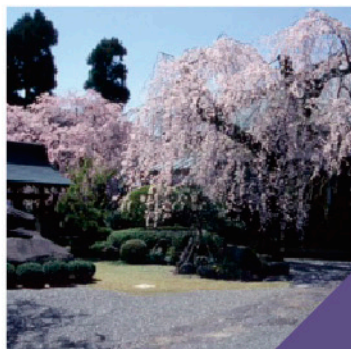
Suyama Mountain Trail

Located approximately 30 minutes by car from Susono I.C.

Suyama is an historical mountain trail established during the Muromachi Period. With Suyama Sengen shrine as its starting point, it winds southeast toward the summit. Its existence as far back as the year 1486 is attested by historical documents. Some of the religious sites along the trail also served as places of pilgrimage for Shugenja pilgrims from the Murakami Sengen Shrine (Koboji Temple). The area covered by the heritage component runs along a mountain path that leads from the former Suyama Trail two–eight station (located at an altitude of 2,050 m, at a point that has become the trailhead of the present-day Gotemba Trail) to the summit. It also leads to the vicinity of Suyama Otainai, which was an object of religious veneration.



Famous Site Visits and Historical Ruins



Jorinji Temple Tomb of Sogi

[Designated Historical Sites of the City]
Kukai opened in the Heian Period, and the Imperial Prince Sadazumi named it Momozono-Jorinji. Later, the temple converted to the Soto sect. A stone tablet marks the grave of the Muromachi Period renga poet Sogi (a designated historical site of the city). In spring, the weeping cherry trees are truly breathtaking.

Fukara Water Supply

[One of Japan's 100 Select Canals-Irrigation Facilities Heritage]
Fukara Yousui is a tunnel that was dug under the Kojiri Pass between 1666 and 1670 to bring water from Lake Ashi to Susono. The length of the tunnel stretches to 1,280 m. Information on the tunnel can be found at the Fukara branch office.

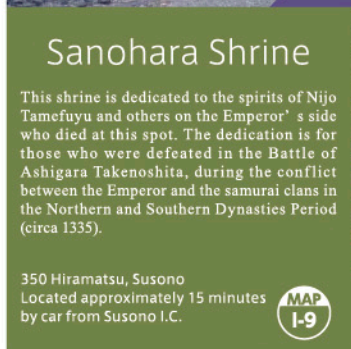

Sanohara Shrine

This shrine is dedicated to the spirits of Nijo Tamefuyu and others on the Emperor's side who died at this spot. The dedication is for those who were defeated in the Battle of Ashigara Takenoshita, during the conflict between the Emperor and the samurai clans in the Northern and Southern Dynasties Period (circa 1335).

Kazurayama Castle Site

[Designated Historical Site of the City]
This site is the central base of the Kazurayama clan, who were part of a group of Imagawa clan samurai lords during the Muromachi and Sengoku periods. The remnants of the dwellings and castle fortifications for war remain in good condition, which makes it a rare historical site even nationwide.

Yoritomo's Well Forest

[Designated Natural Monument of the City]
Yoritomo's Well Forest is a virgin forest mainly consisting of deciduous trees. It is said that when Minamoto no Yoritomo was holding a hunt, he set up lodgings in the area and quenched his thirst with the crystal clear water that gushes forth in this forest.

Jurigi Checkpoint Site

It is speculated that the village of Jurigi, along with protecting the boundaries of the district and the people making their way along the Jurigi Highway, served as a checkpoint, which regulated goods passing across the district border.

Bokusui Wakayama Memorial Room

A museum of materials related to Bokusui Wakayama located in the Susono Civic Culture Center. Bokusui loved the scenery of Susono—its waterfalls, Onohara, and Mt. Fuji—and left behind tanka poems and travels about these areas of natural beauty.

Mt. Fuji Natural Recreation Forest

[Selected as one of Japan's top 100 forests for forest bathing]

A Natural Recreation Forest, which in 1970 became the first in the entire country to receive that designation from the Forestry Agency. It covers an area of over 1,765 hectares across the cities of Fujinomiya, Fuji, Susono, and Gotemba and the town of Oyama. The forest is renowned as a place of woodland recreation for activities such as hiking, camping, and spending time amidst nature.

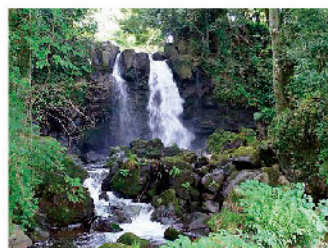


Kairakuen-Fudo Waterfall

A place of true rest and relaxation located about 1 km from Susono Station. The stunning Fudo waterfall is a mountain stream, which flows over a cliff formed by a lava flow. It is approximately 10 m in height, flowing from up high in the lush forest, and it makes for a spectacular sight.

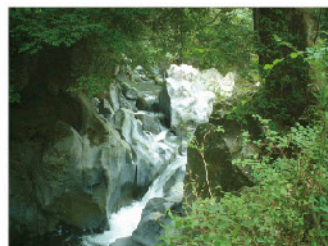
Keigashima Velley

[Designated Scenic Spot of the City]

A ravine rich in beautiful scenery carved out by lava flows from Fuji and agglomerate rock from the Ashitaka volcano. The crags are labeled with names such as Kagura-iwa and Gyusen-iwa, and within the valley, you can find Egyo-ji Temple, which has a connection to the Buddhist monk Kobo Daishi.

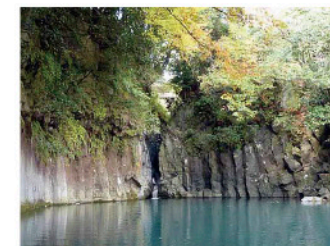
Byobu Cliff

[Designated Natural Monument of the Prefecture]

A spectacular scenic spot located downstream of the Keikeshima Valley. Columnar joints, which contracted when magma from an eruption of Mt. Fuji cooled, created a unique landscape exposed over a height of approximately 10 m and a width of approximately 70 m.

Chuo Park

A lush green park composed of multiple Japanese gardens. Chuo Park is home to the Old Uematsu Family House (designated important cultural property of the nation), a 63-m long suspension bridge, a monument to Bokusui Wakayama, and more. In May, carp banners are hoisted up the Goryu Falls, giving the appearance of carp ascending the waterfall.

Goryu Waterfall

[Designated Natural Monument of the Prefecture]

Witness the 13-m-high waterfall inside Chuo Park. The waterfall flows over a precipice created by a lava flow from Mt. Fuji. The three branches of the main stream (Yukidoke, Fujimi, and Tsukimi) are referred to as the greater falls, and the two branches of its tributary (Choshi and Sagoromo) are the lesser falls.

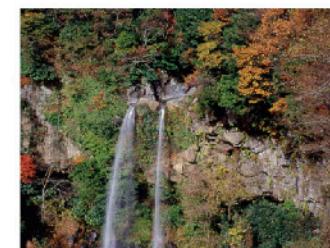


Asahi Waterfall

A phantom waterfall that can only be seen in the aftermath of significant rainfall. It was named Asahi Falls because of the way in which it shines in the morning sun. The height of the falls is approximately 30 m, the plunge pool is deep, and because the bottom is referred to as ledge bottom, the falls are also referred to as the Ledge Return Falls.

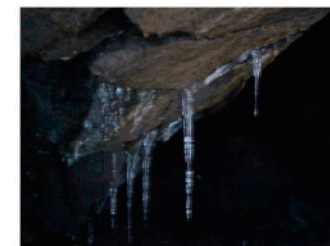
Jurigi Ice Cave

[Designated Natural Monument of the City]

An ice cave created by numerous branching lava flows. It was formed 1,200 years ago by the Jurigi Maruo lava flow that erupted from Mt. Kansu, a volcanic sub-peak of Mt. Fuji. The icicles can be seen until mid-May.

Mt. Ashitaka Hiking

[One of Japan's 200 famous mountains]

The Ashitaka Range is a general term for a number of mountains extending over an area of approximately 60 km in the cities of Susono, Numazu, and Fuji and the town of Nagaizumi, at the southern base of Mt. Fuji. This group consists of nine peaks: Echizen Peak, Ihai Peak, Hakamagoshi Peak, Mt. Ashitaka, Mt. Ohtake, Yobiko Peak, Nokogiri Peak, Kuro Peak, and Mae Peak. It is one of Japan's 200 famous mountains. Along the course, you will find spots such as the Jurigi viewing platform, Echizen Peak, Fuji Overlook, and Kuro Peak viewing platform, along with many other stunning viewing points.

Mt. Fuji Promenade

In the middle of the Mt. Fuji Suyama climbing trail, there is a spot overhung by lush growing trees and hardwoods. The path is a leisurely walk, with relatively few rises and slopes, and in spring, you can witness the vibrant greenery, while the city flower of Susono, the "Ashitaka azalea," comes out in bright pink. In summer, you can seek out a cool spot to escape the heat, and in autumn, you can enjoy the changing foliage of oaks and maples.

<Ashitaka Azalea>

Rare azaleas are native to Mt. Ashitaka and Echizen Peak. The flower has been designated as a valuable natural monument and is of value to scholars.

The azaleas can be seen between mid-May and early June.

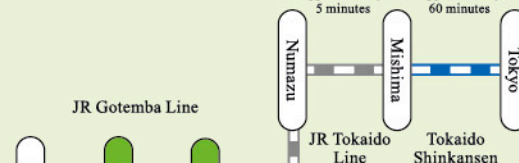
